DIRECTOR'S REPORT -NOVEMBER 2018:

- <u>CONTINUING RESOLUTION:</u> Executive Director Kim Gober reports we are currently operating on a Continuing Resolution until December 7, 2018.
- <u>HUD UPDATES FOR CAPITAL FUND PROGRAM:</u> HUD implemented a new contract, put the contract on the website and if the Housing Authority drew down the money, it automatically meant the HA agreed to the contract. One of the clauses stated the HA would not sue HUD. HUD has since rescinded that after the industry groups balked at this.
- <u>NANCY J. ELKIS:</u> The building has had new cell towers installed on the roof, bringing in \$3400 each month for the lease.
- New flooring has been installed in the foyer at Elkis and we are very pleased with it. The Carpet is gone and the new product is a LVT Product and easy to maintain. The residents seem to like it as well.
- <u>CARINO PARK:</u> New fire alarm panel is being installed.
- <u>COLONIAL PARK:</u> HAGC purchased new LED lighting. This will save on Management time.
- <u>SHEPHERD'S FARM:</u> The budget is approved. (PRAC has been executed with a rent increase)
- <u>RESOLUTIONS FOR EMEX:</u> This is a Reverse Auction for Utilities (Gas and Electric). We hope to have savings on the Utilities with this. The contract can be for 12, 18, or 24 months. They recommend 24 months.
- <u>SECURITY</u>: There are three Resolutions on the Agenda pertaining to the Security for the Buildings. The former Security Company went out of business and gave us very little time to prepare. We entered into a Contract for a month with Triton Security. Bids went out at the same time and <u>We See You Security</u> won the bids. Their credentials have been checked and passed.
- <u>CONFERENCES:</u>
 - The Executive Director Kim Gober and the IT Director, Alma Asllanaj attended a Conference in Atlanta, GA for a Software User Conference from October 15-17. The Company who took over Tenmast, our software company, is MRI. MRI Focuses on the Real Estate Market. In the last year they have acquired 4 Software Companies that manage Affordable Housing. Right now they are developing a product will take the best components of all four software companies and blend them into a new product.
