■ DIRECTOR'S REPORT – JANUARY 2017

- Executive Director Kimberly Gober reported three buildings were out of power. Two had problems with the elevators. The Nancy Elkis building had a fuse blown and that was corrected. Colonial Park had parts overnighted and power has been restored to that elevator as well. The third problem was in Shepherds Farm and HAGC staff thought they would have to evacuate the building. Residents responded which is a plus. The problem was a pin hole in one of the pipes and the compressor blew a circuit breaker. The compressor needs to be replaced. Our staff was on fire watch until the problem was rectified.
- Operating Subsidy litigation: A motion was filed for summary judgment. The judge awarded in favor of the plaintiffs. It appears that we may be, at some point, entitled to this money. (\$510,000) HAGC still has to go through quite a process before we get it. This was a class action lawsuit filed in 2012 in conjunction with PHADA AND NAHRO.
- All of applications have been entered from the Voucher list (1600 total).



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• VASH: we are up to 15 referrals. Eight (8) have been housed. The Chairman is proud of everyone involved in getting this done. This has been in the works for a long time. Kim voiced that HUD's motto is "Housing First".

Commissioner Smith arrived: 4:40 PM

Commissioner Purnell is happy to hear that the VA will be helping to take care of the Vets being housed. The Chairman noted that there is a whole support system involving the VA with the Vets being housed. He wished we would have 1000 Vouchers but we only have 19. It's a start. Administratively, Commissioner Kintzing questioned how would these homeless Vets give the information needed to apply to the program. Jessica Laine reported their case manager at the Veterans Administration will look into finding the information that these Vets need.

• Handouts are given to the Commissioners to give some insight at what is happening in the Housing Industry today. The Chairman attended a seminar concerning the security of our Housing Authority and reported it was excellent. It is in our best interest to have a seminar at HAGC. We would like to reserve this seminar for the date of the next board meeting in March (March 22nd, 2017). A retired Postal Detective Inspector, Felix Nader, will be educating our employees, management and commissioners on the security and what is happening in the Housing Industry today. This will be reserved before the next meeting, convening about 3 PM. An email reminder will be sent out to the Commissioners a week before as well as a few days before. The chairman noted that no one left the room during this hour and a half session, it was that interesting.
