<u>DEXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT:</u>

- WE WOULD LIKE TO WELCOME BACK JESSICA LAINE, ESQ. FROM HER MATERNITY LEAVE. SHE IS THE PROUD MOM OF BABY COLTON.
- <u>CAPITAL FUND:</u> WE RECEIVED NOTICE FOR \$511,000 IN FUNDING, WHICH IS INTENDED FOR <u>PUBLIC HOUSING</u> MODERNIZATION. (CARINO PARK, DEPTFORD PARK AND THE HOUSES)
- <u>HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER PROGRAM (HCV)</u>: ALOTTED \$16 MILLION DOLLARS IN FUNDING BUT WE DON'T HAVE THE ADMIN FEE PRORATION SO WE DON'T KNOW ADMINISTRATIVELY WHAT OUR FUNDING IS YET.
- <u>NJHMFA:</u> THE MANAGING AGENT EVALUATIONS FOR BOTH COLONIAL PARK AND NANCY ELKIS WERE "EXCELLENT".
- <u>SEMAP:</u> HAGC WAS RATED AS A "HIGH PERFORMER"
- <u>HUD:</u> HUD IS CHANGING ITS INSPECTION PROTOCOL TO 14 DAYS NOTICE WHICH IS A PROBLEM. IF THE INSPECTOR CANNOT COME OUT TO THE HOUSING AUTHORITY WITHIN THEIR 14 DAYS NOTICE, THE HA RECEIVES A PENCIL "0". IF THE INSPECTOR CANNOT COME OUT WITHIN 21 DAYS, IT IS A FINAL "0". WE ARE IN THE PROCESS OF LEARNING THE NEW PROTOCOL AND SCORING METHODS.



REGULAR BOARD MEETING

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- <u>HUD:</u> THEY WANT TO MAKE CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS MANDATORY. HAGC IS AHEAD OF THE GAME SINCE THE STATE OF NJ HAS ALREADY MADE IT MANDATORY.
- LEAD BASED PAINT GRANT: WE HAVE DETERMINED THAT HAGC WILL RESCIND THE FUNDING. HAGC HAS DECIDED TO SELL THE HOUSES AND AT THE RATE IN WHICH THE APPROVAL FROM HUD TAKES, IT WILL HOLD UP THE SALE OF THE HOUSES. IT IS BEST TO GIVE THE MONEY BACK TO HUD NOW SO THEY CAN AWARD THE FUNDING TO ANOTHER ENTITIY. HAGC DID NOT AWARD THE CONTRACT.

ANY COMMENTS OR CONCERNS FROM THE COMMISSIONERS:

<u>Commissioner Kintzing</u>: Is "high performer" the best score we can receive on the SEMAP score?

Executive Director Gober: Yes, but we could have done better. HUD did not like the maps we used so we can correct that for 2019 but not for 2018. HUD wants us to provide more detail about areas with a higher economic opportunity but we have to be cautious not to put a negative perspective on some other areas.

Commissioner Smith: Would you like us to approve the Lead Based Paint Resolutions now? **Chairman Bain:** Resolutions #19-35 Resolution to Rescind the Acceptance of the Lead Based Paint Capital Fund Grant and #19-36 Resolution to Rescind the Award of the Contract for the Lead Based Assessment
